



The CrousCalogero studio was inspired to design a balloon lamp for the Estiluz company which, rather than disappearing into the skies, appears to float against the ceiling. Inside the translucent plastic shade is an LED lamp that is switched on and off by a red cord that also controls the level of light. It casts a pleasing illumination and is guaranteed not to take off.
